

Weddings: Responsorial Psalm

803 (1)

Psalm 33. 12+18, 20-21, 22 (R.5b)

Response: The earth is full of the steadfast love of the Lord. (R)

- 12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord,
the people whom he has chosen as his heritage.
- 18 Truly the eye of the LORD is on those who fear him,
on those who hope in his steadfast love. *(R.)*
- 20 Our soul waits for the LORD;
he is our help and shield.
- 21 Our heart is glad in him,
because we trust in his holy name. *(R.)*
- 22 Let your steadfast love, O LORD, be upon us,
even as we hope in you. *(R.)*

Weddings: Responsorial Psalm

803 (2)

Psalm 34. 1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8 (R. 1a or 8a)

Response: I will bless the LORD at all times. (R.)

Or: Taste and see that the LORD is good.

- 1 I will bless the LORD at all times;
his praise shall continually be in my mouth.
- 2 My soul makes its boast in the LORD;
let the humble hear and be glad. *(R.)*
- 3 O magnify the LORD with me,
and let us exalt his name together.
- 4 I sought the LORD, and he answered me,
and delivered me from all my fears. *(R.)*
- 5 Look to him, and be radiant;
so your faces shall never be ashamed.
- 6 The poor one called, and the LORD heard,
and saved that person from every trouble. *(R.)*
- 7 The Angel of the LORD encamps
around those who fear him, and delivers them.
- 8 O taste and see that the LORD is good;
blessed are those who take refuge in him. *(R.)*

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803 (3)

Psalm 103. 1-2, 8+13, 17-18a (R. 8a or 17)

Response: The LORD is merciful and gracious. (R.)

*Or: The steadfast love of the LORD is everlasting
on those who fear him.*

1 Bless the LORD, O my soul,
and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

2 Bless the LORD, O my soul,
and do not forget all his benefits. *(R.)*

8 The LORD is merciful and gracious,
slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

13 As a father has compassion for his children,
so the LORD has compassion for those who fear him. *(R.)*

17 The steadfast love of the LORD
is from everlasting to everlasting
on those who fear him,
and his righteousness to children's children,

18 to those who keep his covenant. *(R.)*

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803 (4)

Psalm 112. 1-2, 3-4, 5-7a, 7bc-8, 9 (R. see 1)

*Response: Blessed is the one
who greatly delights in the LORD's commandments.*

Or: Alleluia!

- 1 Blessed is the one who fears the LORD,
who greatly delights in his commandments.
- 2 Their descendants will be mighty in the land;
the generation of the upright will be blessed. *(R.)*
- 3 Wealth and riches are in their house,
and their righteousness endures forever.
- 4 Light rises in the darkness for the upright:
gracious, merciful, and righteous. *(R.)*
- 5 It is well with the person who deals generously and lends,
who conducts their affairs with justice.
- 6 For the righteous person will never be moved;
- 7 they will be remembered forever, unafraid of evil tidings. *(R.)*
- 8 Their heart is firm, secure in the LORD.
That person's heart is steady and will not be afraid;
in the end they will look in triumph on their foes. *(R.)*
- 9 One who has distributed freely, who has given to the poor,
their righteousness endures forever:
their name is exalted in honour. *(R.)*

803 (5)

Psalm 128. 1-2, 3, 4-5 (R. see 1a)

Response: Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD. (R.)

- 1 Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD,
who walks in his ways.
- 2 You shall eat the fruit of the labour of your hands;
you shall be happy, and it shall go well with you. *(R.)*
- 3 Your wife will be like a fruitful vine
within your house;
your children will be like olive shoots
around your table. *(R.)*
- 4 Thus shall the man be blessed who fears the LORD.
- 5 The LORD bless you from Zion.
May you see the prosperity of Jerusalem
all the days of your life. *(R.)*

Weddings: Responsorial Psalm

803 (6)

Psalm 145. 8-9, 10+15, 17-18 (R. 9a)

Response: The LORD is good to all. (R.)

- 8 The LORD is gracious and merciful,
 slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.
- 9 The LORD is good to all,
 and his compassion is over all that he has made. *(R.)*
- 10 All your works shall give thanks to you, O LORD,
 and all your faithful shall bless you.
- 15 The eyes of all look to you,
 and you give them their food in due season. *(R.)*
- 17 The LORD is just in all his ways,
 and kind in all his doings.
- 18 The LORD is near to all who call on him,
 to all who call on him in truth. *(R.)*

Weddings: Responsorial Psalm

803 (7)

Psalm 148. 1-2, 3-4, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14a (R. s13a)

Response: Let them praise the name of the LORD. (R.)

Or: Alleluia!

- 1 Praise the LORD from the heavens;
praise him in the heights!
- 2 Praise him, all his angels;
praise him, all his host! *(R.)*
- 3 Praise him, sun and moon;
praise him, all you shining stars!
- 4 Praise him, you highest heavens,
and you waters above the heavens! *(R.)*
- 9 Mountains and all hills,
fruit trees and all cedars!
- 10 Wild animals and all cattle,
creeping things and flying birds! *(R.)*
- 11 Kings of the earth and all peoples,
princes and all rulers of the earth!
- 12 Young men and women alike,
old and young together! *(R.)*
- 13 Let them praise the name of the LORD,
for his name alone is exalted.
His glory is above earth and heaven.
- 14 He has raised up a horn for his people. *(R.)*
